<u>Division 2: Professional</u> Individuals with past/present professional experience in the culinary field, ex. business owners

<u>Division 3: Young Bakers</u> Youth category for bakers ages 15 and under

How to enter? Complete the entry form below. Please register and pay the \$5.00 registration fee by the deadline. Contest entry forms will be posted on the Heritage Alliance's Facebook, the Taste of Tennessee Facebook, and the Heritage Alliance's website.

When to enter: The deadline for registration and payment is Thursday, September 21, 2023 by 5:00 PM EST. Judging begins on Sunday, September 24th at 1:30 PM EST.

When should I drop off my entry? Participants should arrive at the Visitors Center parking lot (117 Boone Street) to drop off their cake by 12:30 PM EST on Sunday, September 24th, 2023. Winners will be announced later that afternoon. The public sampling period will take place between 3:00 PM and 5:00 PM EST. Exhibitors must remove any of their dishware or personal effects between 5:00 PM and 6:00 PM on Sunday, September 24.

Limited Entries The contest will have limited entries on a first come, first serve basis. Limit one entry per individual. The entry fee is \$5.00, and participants are asked to allow the remainder of their dishes to be offered to the public following the formal judging competition in order to benefit The Heritage Alliance.
